About Dance Marathon at FSU

Dance Marathon at Florida State University is a student-run philanthropy dedicated to raising funds for our local beneficiaries, UF Health Shands Children's Hospital and FSU's College of Medicine Pediatric Outreach Programs.

Our year-long movement culminates in a weekend-long event where about 2,000 students stay awake and on their feet to raise money and awareness for our cause. In 2022, DM at FSU raised \$1,554,156.14 for Miracle Children. As the third largest Dance Marathon program in the country, both in funds raised and student participation, DM at FSU has raised over 18 million dollars in the past 27 years. We are

the largest student-run philanthropy in the southeastern region of the United States.
